

Part 2: Working with Figures

Shape Clipping



Some figure shapes, like ovals, clouds, and triangles, can auto inflate their bounds to minimize content (text or image) clipping.

However you can turn off the auto inflate option in the Shape inspector if you wish.



The result is a clipped image since auto inflate is disabled.

Oval

You can tell Curio to clip the image to a given mask instead. So the entire figure has one shape while the image within is clipped to a different shape.



So now the figure is still rounded rectangle while the image is clipped to an oval.
