Squidoo Links User Manual

1) To unlock the software enter the password into the Enter Code box then press Unlock



A thank you box will then appear press OK and your ready to start using Squidoo Links.



2) Squidoo Links lets you create normal, bold and image links.

I am going to use the Squidoo Links website as an example on how to create each link, just change my details for yours when you want to start generating your own Squidoo Links.

To create a normal link all you need to do is enter the details below.

Once you have inputted **Your Domain** and **Link Title** click on the **Generate** button, and your code will appear in the Html Code box. All you need to do now is right click anywhere over the code then press on the Copy button, it's as simple as that.

To generate a Bold link is the same process except you need to change the link type from normal to Bold link.

3) To create an image link click on the Image Link button, and choose the position you would like the image to appear on your Squidoo Lens.

I have chosen to have my image in the center position as the example below shows.

To create a clickable image link you need to input where your chosen image is being stored in the **Picture Link** box, fill in the **Your Domain** and **Link Title**. If you created a normal or bold link earlier you will not need to input this again. You now have the 3 boxes filled out click on the **Generate** button, and your code will appear in the Html Code box. All you need to do now is right click anywhere over the code then press on the Copy button.

When you have finished creating all your links and you shut down the software, a box like the one below marked application will appear next to the Squidoo Links icon, don't worry this is the application.dat file. This is where the password is stored so that you never need to enter the unlock code again.



Creating Squidoo Links is as easy as that, hope you enjoy this easy to use and simple piece of software, and good luck with your Squidoo Lenses.
